




This is a Reminiscence Roadshow about the films of the 1940's and 50's, created from the memories of those who lived and worked in Ealing at the time.


AUTHOR AND JOURNALIST RORY CELLAN-JONES AT NORTHFIELDS COMMUNITY LIBRARY




